No Place Called Home is near and dear to my heart having been a creative project of mine for the past 5 years.

After traveling to the Middle East in 2009 as part of the "Iraqi Voices Amplification Project" with New York-based non-profit Intersections International, I was commissioned to write this play to call attention to one of the most urgent and underreported social justice crises of our time: the Iraqi refugee crisis.

Almost 5 million people were displaced after the U.S. military intervention. The world landscape has changed since then, but what hasn't changed is the dire situation of refugees worldwide.

Syrian refugees have left their country by the millions, and a new wave of Iraqis are forced to flee yet again with the threat of ISIS. There is an even more urgent need to tell these stories. And *No Place Called Home* is mine--and theirs. It's an autobiographical love story and a solo performance in which I play about 12 different Iraqi characters.
