Not Quite White - A Documentary - Free to View

A film dedicated to a vision of whiteness that is anti-racist and rooted in economic justice.

[Not Quite White: Arabs, Slavs and the Contours of Contested Whiteness](#) expands the American conversation on race by zeroing in on whiteness as a constructed social and political category, a slippery slope that historically played favorites, advantaging Northern and Western European immigrants over immigrants from Eastern and Southern Europe and the Middle East.



White integrates scenes from *WASP* alongside interviews with Arab American and Polish American academics who reflect upon contested and probationary categories of whiteness and the use of anti-Black racism as a “whitening” dye.
