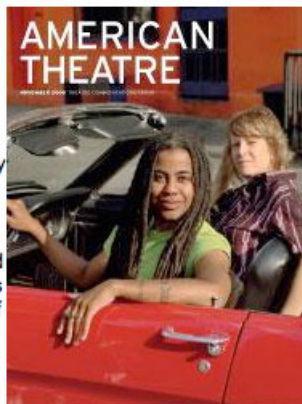

ABOUT 365 DAYS/365 PLAYS
The play cycle by Suzan-Lori Parks

On November 13, 2002, SUZAN-LORI PARKS got an idea to write a play a day for a year. She began that very day, finishing one year later. The resulting play cycle, called 365 Days/365Plays, is a daily meditation on an artistic life. Some plays are very short, less than a page. Others last forever.



The plays are brief, brilliant, tragic and hilarious explorations of what it means to be American, all through the lens of one of our most exciting theatrical voices.

Over 900 theatre companies in 15 cities across the nation are involved in this unique theatrical experiment. Each city is comprised of a network of 60 theatre companies and each company tackles one week of the plays.
