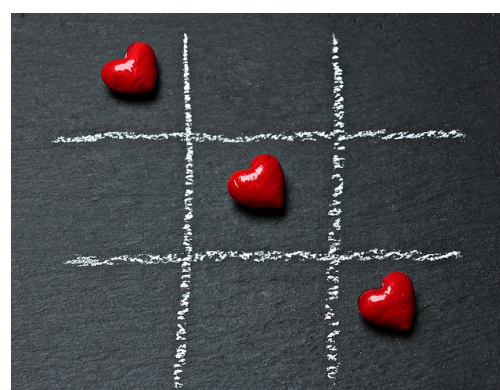
Twice, Thrice, Fricé

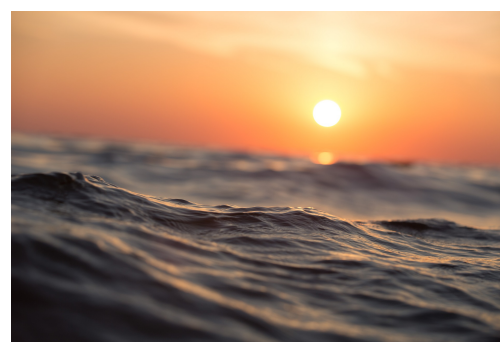

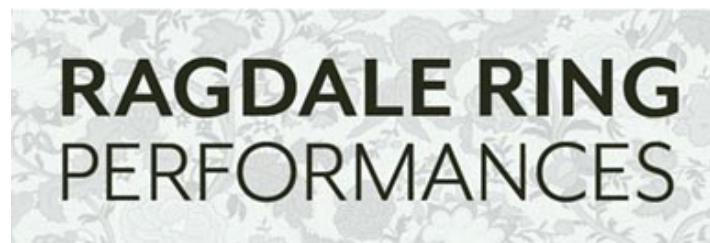
