Becoming is a monthly program hosted by Collaboraction's Artistic Director Anthony Moseley and Executive Director Dr. Marcus Robinson. The virtual gathering provides space and fellowship for people looking to understand White Privilege, unlearn inherent White Supremacy, engage in meaningful dialogue around systems of oppression with others, and support each other in being actively anti-racist moving forward. As a group, we will explore critical elements of racism and White Supremacy, including history, modern-day events/issues, best practices for communications, and share our journeys.



September's session of *Becoming*, featuring panelists Roxane Assaf, Jamil Khoury, and Fouad Teymour, will include a screening of Silk Road Rising's short documentary *Not Quite White: Arabs, Slavs, and the Contours of Contested Whiteness*. The panel investigates how Arab immigrants to the U.S. have historically achieved degrees of whiteness and hence qualified as more "fully American." The conversation will also reflect on contested categories of whiteness and the use of anti-black racism as a "whitening" dye.
